EDUCATIONAL PROJECT INSPIRED TO JUNE 26, 1959
IN OLGiate OLONA SECONDARY SCHOOL:
THE STUDENTS AUTHORS OF THE TEN WORTHY WORKS

Even in 2014 the Municipal administration of Olgiate Olona valorizes the educational project – now in its fifth year - inspired to the plane crash of June 26, 1959. During the commemoration of Thursday, June 26, 2014, at 5.33 p.m., newly elected Olgiate Olona Mayor Giovanni Montano will reward the students in eighth grade of “Dante Alighieri” school (section of “Beato Contardo Ferrini” Comprehensive Institute), authors of the ten worthy works which were received anonymously and judged by a jury outside the school who later announced the identity of the authors.

Here are the names of the students in alphabetical order and their worthy works (in parentheses) which best interpret the historical fact and the meaning of commemorative events: De Pretto Simone (*Settanta vite*); Dipasquale Andrea (*Era il 26 giugno 1959*); Lomi Roberto (*Settanta vite innocenti*); Mariani Michela (*Non facciamo tacere la memoria!*); Martucci Andrea (*Anche io ho imparato a volare*); Paganini Ilaria (*La luce nella notte*); Pallotti Gian Alberto (*Mary*); Saporiti Katia (*Quel momento*); Sarker Payel (*Cara mamma sono dentro di te...*); Tonelli Aurora (*7 luglio 1959. Cara mamma...*).

These students and their parents received a letter by the Mayor as invitation to attend the ceremony of June 26, 2014. During the ceremony the students will receive a merit certificate and the authors - only if present - of the first three classified works (whose identity will be revealed during the ceremony, not before) will be awarded with a book voucher (value 100, 75, 50 euro) and will read their works.
